Positives:

KS3 LAC and FSM in Reading and Writing secure above expected progress.
Alignment between Reading and Writing within KS3.
KS3 LAC in Science secured above expected progress and KS3 FSM secured expected progress.
KS3 LAC in Maths secured above expected progress and KS3 FSM secured expected progress.
KS4 LAC in Maths secured above expected progress and KS4 FSM secured expected progress.

Improvements / Challenges:

KS4 LAC progress in English is below expected progress. Attendance and engagement in lessons has been poor. Year 10 Science progress doesn't align to EKS3 Teacher Assessment. Pupil engagement and safety within the laboratory is generally poor.
Year 8 Science assessment date has validity issues, and subsequently has a negative impact across all target groups.

KS4 NFSM in English is working below expected progress - aligned to Year 10 cohort.
Dipsarity between Reading and Writing KS3.
3 pupils in 8b are working below expected progress
