Harmful words / messages / defamatory language.	We appreciate that the consequences are clear and appropriate to the perpetrator but what about the impact on others witnessing / hearing these comments.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Leaders explicitly share with parents / carers who have been directly impacted (perpetrator and victim) and next steps.Leaders to share with form tutor staff to utilise discussion during form time about the impact the incident could have on others.Tutor staff to utilise Behaviour Blueprint proforma (whole group) to look at how the incident has impacted on them as a collective.
